



Moderator's Report

It has been so encouraging to see how churches have ministered to people during this pandemic. Our sense of community has been challenged but the creative ideas for worship and ministry from our church staff have been greatly appreciated.

Our MBCM staff team of Cam, Jason, and Amanda have done great work for us in the past year. They continue to adapt to changing health directives as they provide services to churches and organize events.

The Collaborative Model has been developing very well under the leadership of Elton and the CCMBC executive board. The positive working relationship at the National Ministry team, which includes Cam and his provincial/agency colleagues, has been very encouraging to us. Ruth has done great work representing us at the CCMBC executive board. All of us as provinces, CCMBC, and our agencies continue to work to develop the Collaborative Model.

As an MBCM board, we have really valued the ongoing work of our Provincial Faith and Life team. The guidance of Jason and his team have been invaluable to us.

Single-stream funding has worked very well. In the past, funds sent by churches include a portion of their revenue for MBCM and CCMBC. Single source funding asks for that combined amount to be sent to MBCM, and a portion of that amount is forwarded to CCMBC. As in previous years, we are again asking churches to

contribute 13% toward single stream funding.

We are incredibly grateful for the ongoing support from our churches. Your prayers, support for our staff, participation at events and financial support is all greatly appreciated. As the enclosed financial information indicates, your support allowed us to meet all our commitments in 2021.

We were also able to complete the sale of the Henderson property to MBCI. As part of the sale, all current tenants will continue with the MBCI.

I would like to thank each of our MBCM board members for their participation. It has been a privilege to serve our churches in the past year and we thank you for that!

It has been a great experience for me to serve at both MBCM and CCMBC. My faith has grown as has my love for the church. It is truly humbling to be part of a community that cares for each other and engages in conversation to understand one another, as we discern God's will for us together. Sometimes we can be tempted to rush to decisions or timelines when taking the time to walk alongside each other in meaningful dialogue is what is really needed.
